**RESOLUTION CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND
DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE NOVEMBER 8,
2022 GENERAL ELECTION FOR THREE (3) CITY
OFFICERS**

WHEREAS, the City Officers election was held on the 8th day of November, 2022, for the purpose of electing the Mayor, a City Council Member to represent District 3, and a City Council Member to represent District 4, each to serve a three-year term; and

WHEREAS, it is hereby found and determined that said election was held in accordance with the authorized procedures, that notice of the election was duly given in the form, manner, and time required by law, and that said election was in all respects legally held and conducted in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas applicable thereto; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City Council to canvass the returns of said election and to declare the results thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIDLAND, TEXAS:

SECTION ONE. That the state of the polls in each precinct is shown in Exhibit A, attached hereto and made a part hereof for all purposes.

SECTION TWO. That from the returns duly and legally made, there were 40,245 valid and legal voters; and that each of the candidates in said election received the following votes:

SECTION FIVE. That after obtaining the statement of elected officer as required by Section Four, above, but not earlier than January 9, 2023, the City Secretary, or her designee, shall administer the oath of office required by Article 16, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the State of Texas to the duly elected individual listed in Section Three, above.
