WHEREAS, the City Officers election was held on the 5th day of November, 2024, for the purpose of electing a City Council Member to represent District 1, a City Council Member to represent District 2, and two At-Large City Council Members, each to serve a three-year term; and

WHEREAS, a special election was held on such date to approve or reject the conveyance of a 3.74-acre tract of land out of Blocks 29 and 36, East Midland Addition, City and County of Midland, Texas, said tract being a portion of Hidalgo Park that is mostly unimproved, to Midland Soup Kitchen Ministry, a nonprofit organization, to be used in a manner that primarily promotes a public purpose of the City of Midland, Texas; and

WHEREAS, it is hereby found and determined that said elections were held in accordance with the authorized procedures, that notice of said elections were duly given in the form, manner, and time required by law, and that said elections were in all respects legally held and conducted in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas applicable thereto; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City Council to canvass the returns of said elections and to declare the results thereof;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF MIDLAND, TEXAS:**

SECTION ONE. That the state of the polls in each precinct is shown in Exhibit A,

attached hereto and made a part hereof for all purposes.

“Shall the City of Midland, Texas be authorized to convey to Midland Soup Kitchen Ministry, a nonprofit organization, to be used in a manner that primarily promotes a public purpose of the City of Midland, Texas a 3.74-acre tract of land, being a portion of Hidalgo Park that is mostly unimproved, and being situated in Blocks 29 and 36, along with the unopened road between said Blocks, East Midland Addition, as shown on the plat recorded in Volume 1, on Pages 51 through 56 of the Deed Records of Midland County, Texas and being a portion of the lands conveyed to the City of Midland in Volume 34 on Page 12 of said Deed Records and being more particularly described as follows:

“Beginning at N.(y): 10697977.18, E.(x): 1760567.65 a one half inch iron rod with an aluminum cap marked “COM” found for the northeast corner of said Block 29, in the west line of North Carver Avenue on the south line of the Mulberry Channel (Mulberry Lane) for the northeast corner hereof;

“Thence S.14°27’25”E., along said North Carver Avenue, 679.99 feet to a spike nail with whiskers found in the north line of Orchard Lane for the southeast corner hereof;

“Thence S.75°31’24”W., along said Orchard Lane, 60.00 feet to a mag nail set at the southeast corner of a tract conveyed to the Midland Soup Kitchen, Inc., in a special warranty deed filed as Document Number 2814 on page 1152 on page 345 of said Deed Records for an exterior corner hereof;

“Thence the following four courses and distance around said Soup Kitchen tract;

1. N.14°27’25”W., 160.02 feet to a mag nail set;
2. S.75°31’24”W., 150.00 to a one half inch iron rod with a red plastic cap marked “Maverick Firm# 10194514” (RPC) set;
3. S.14°27’25”E., 99.98 feet to an “RPC” set;
4. S.75°31’24”W., 90.00 feet to a bent one half inch iron rod found in the west line of said Block 36 for the southwest corner hereof;

“Thence N.07°25’57”E., 54.57 feet to a chain link fence corner found for an interior corner hereof;

“Thence N.14°34’39”W., 569.31 feet to a one half inch iron rod found in the south line of said Mulberry Channel for the northwest corner hereof;

“Thence N.75°31’24”E., along said Mulberry Channel, 280.85 feet to the point of beginning, containing 162832 square feet or 3.74 acres of land?”

SECTION FIVE. That after obtaining the statement of said elected officers as required by Section Four, above, but not earlier than January 13, 2025, the City Secretary, or her designee, shall administer the oath of office required by Article 16, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the State of Texas to the duly elected officers listed in Section Three.
